



Governance and climate justice: Inclusive governance processes (incl. VNR) enable effective action to address climate change and its impacts.

- **SDG 16+ in action at country level:** support multi-stakeholder planning, monitoring, reporting and implementation.
- **Evidence-base for action to achieve SDG 13 :** Identify needs with respect to addressing climate change and its impacts, and community owned, nature-based solutions.
- **Political will for action to achieve SDG 13:** Promote accountability for action to address climate change and its impacts.
- **Enable partnerships for effective to achieve SDG 13:** Unite government, private sector, communities, civil society and academia for the joint action needed to achieve SDG 13.



Climate change and effective action to address it: a governance problem requiring a governance solution.

- 13.1** Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate-related hazards and natural disasters in all countries
- 13.2** Integrate climate change measures into **national policies, strategies and planning.**
- 13.3** Improve education, awareness-raising and human and **institutional capacity** on climate change mitigation, adaptation, impact reduction and early warning.
- 13.A** Implement commitment undertaken by developed-country parties to the UNFCCC to a goal of mobilizing jointly \$100 billion annually by 2020 from all sources to address the needs of developing countries in the context of meaningful mitigation actions and transparency on implementation and fully operationalize the Green Climate Fund through its capitalization as soon as possible.
- 13.B** Promote mechanisms for raising capacity for effective **climate change-related planning and management** in least developed countries and small island developing States, including **focusing on women, youth and local and marginalized communities.**
